**Who is organizing this Competency Validation Survey and what is the purpose of it?**

The regulatory bodies of NL, ON & BC are collaborating in a project to develop a listing of inter-jurisdictional practice competencies that may become a common requirement for entry-to-practice in each province.

Practice competencies are descriptions of job tasks that may be carried out by RMTs. We will ask you about the job tasks that you carry out in your work.

The purpose of asking about this is to help us develop a listing of job tasks in which entry-to-practice RMTs should be proficient. As in any profession, entry-level RMTs come to the workplace with a combination of knowledge, skills and other attributes that enables them to carry out certain job tasks in a proficient manner. The regulatory bodies need to assess the knowledge, skills and attributes of applicants, in order to register them and to ensure the provision of safe, effective and ethical care to the public.

**The survey opens March 1, 2010 and will be available until March 31, 2010.**
